Plant Library Program

Do you enjoy greenery and living colour in your room? Are you interested in bringing outside green spaces indoors but are unsure how to do that? Well, you are in luck! The Mobile Plant Library Program is currently open to all Trinity Village Care Centre residents.



This program allows you to bring green spaces indoors by offering a selection of houseplants each month provided by our on-site horticulture team. The plant you select will be placed in your living space for your enjoyment. Our on-site horticulturalist or volunteer will also provide you with plant care instructions and all the necessary resources so that you can confidently provide the care that your borrowed plant requires. If the plant becomes undesirable or warrants extra care, you will have the opportunity to switch out your plant each month when the Mobile Plant Library visits your home area.

Our mobile Plant Library that visits each of the five houses in Trinity Village Care Centre includes, in part, selections of small succulent gardens, flowering mezoo, colorful croton, and stripy spider plants. If you remember a favourite houseplant and we don't currently offer it as a selection, ask the Horticulturalist to consider adding it to the library. We are always open to suggestions. The Mobile Plant Library will visit the home area on assigned dates to show off our current indoor plant selection, provide information about each plant and answer any questions you may have. By the end of the visit, you will be matched with the perfect plant for your living space. Whether you like a sun-loving aloe vera, a shadeloving pothos, or have drowned plants in the past and need a water-loving spider plant, we have you covered.
