**Purpose:** The Mobile Plant Library gives elders at Trinity Village the chance to care for an indoor plant, encouraging social interaction, reducing loneliness, and adding purpose to their day.

**Role Overview:** Volunteers visit residents weekly to help with simple plant care (watering, checking light/temperature) and enjoy friendly conversation. Plants are matched to each resident's preferences and abilities.

- Visits currently take place on Tuesdays: 9:15–11:30 a.m | 1:00–3:00 p.m
- Interest in plants and basic plant care (training provided)
- Comfortable documenting short notes
